

## KANSAS CITY over Houston by 13

#### OPENING LINES: CHIEFS -8 / 42.5

et's start with this note of interest: The Chiefs have ripped the limbs off the Texans in each of the two playoff games they met, winning the two contests by 50 points while beating the spread by 31 points combined. Kansas City is on a **6-0 SUATS** heater in its last postseason games. They are also 9-2 SU and 8-3 ATS in playoff games under Andy Reid against .667 or fewer foes. Not to mention the Mustache's **8-1 ATS** career record in the game when coming off a loss of more than 24 points. And they return to Arrowhead off a 38-0 loss - albeit with practice squad players. Does a one-legged duck swim in circles? Of course, they do. They've also got a first-ever "three-peat" embedded in their mind. Before the "practice squad" loss to the Broncos to conclude the season, Kansas City was playing arguably its best ball of the season, riding a sixgame win skein. They toppled the Texans like Custer at Little Big Horn, winning seven of the last nine battles by an average win margin of more than 13 points per game. And we didn't even mention QB Patrick Mahomes and his 15-3 SU and 13-5 ATS career mark in the playoffs, including **6-0 outright** in initial games by an average winning margin of more than 15 points per game. The best part is that Houston figures to oblige, sitting smack dab in the **AWESOME ANGLE OF THE WEEK**. With Texans' QB C.J. Stroud's weak 1-4 SUATS career record against foes with greater than .700-win percentage, it looks like more misery ahead for Houston at Arrowhead.

#### OPENING LINES: LIONS -10.5 / 56

Any the doinks be with you. That's the popular toast Commanders fans are saying these days. It's also likely the last time they'll be drinking to the same this football season, given the Lions' roaring 14-2 SU and 11-4-1 ATS mark when laying points this campaign. However, much like the onerous stat called out against Houston in the other game being played today is the fact that any team in the Divisional Round, coming off an upset win as an underdog in the Wild Card Round, is **0-15 SU and 3-12 ATS** as a road dog if they won five or fewer games the previous season. Jayden Daniels and the Washington Commanders doinked their way to a dramatic victory over the Tampa Bay Buccaneers on Sunday, ending two lengthy droughts. Washington's last playoff victory was in January 2006, when Daniels was just 6 years old, and a rookie quarterback hadn't won on the road in the postseason since 2012. To top it off, Washington never punted in a 23-20 victory. And to top it off, the Commanders reside inside this week's **INCREDIBLE STAT** on page 2. However, don't look for that to happen here. It's safe to say it's rare when an NFL Rookie quarterback wins a game on the road in the playoffs, as they are just 5-16 outright overall on the playoff road. And talk about amazement, in a significant surprise, Lions RB David Montgomery is back after he suffered what was thought to be a season-ending knee injury in Week 15. With Detroit head coach Dan Campbell looking to wipe the egg off his face from the puzzling 4th down calls he made down the stretch in the playoffs last year that cost his team a trip to the Super Bowl, the "Lions' Den" is not where the Commanders want to be today.

## PHILADELPHIA over LA Rams by 3

#### OPENING LINES: EAGLES -6.5 / 45

IV Eagles Fly will be anxious to make amends from last year's oneand-done playoff appearance when they gagged 32-9 as road chalk at Tampa Bay in the Wild Card Round. A significant concern to Eagles fans, though, has to be the loss of LB Nakobe Dean, who went down to a torn patellar tendon in Philly's loss to the Packers on Sunday. He and Zack Baun formed the best tandem of LBs in the league; pairing them was the first thing Vic Fangio did when he took over as Dc. Dean wore the communications helmet, and the defensive captain relayed the Eagles' defensive play calls. And speaking of defense, the Rams sacked QB Sam Darnold 9 times in their surprisingly easy upset win over the Vikings. The Rams started the season 0-2, and eventually 1-4. However, since coming off their Bye week in mid-October, Sean McVay's squad has gone 10-3 SU and 9-4 ATS. It's also when star WRs Cooper Kupp and Puca Nacua returned in tandem to the starting lineup. Surprisingly, the Rams are 5-1 ITS against fellow playoff squads this season; the Eagles are just 3-5 ITS. Yes, the Eagles are 16-6 SU and 17-4-1 ATS in this series since 1990, including 5-0 ATS when favored by more than three points. Our biggest concern, though, is Philly flattened the Rams, 37-20, in Los Angeles in late November (it was LA's only stat loss in six games against a playoff squad this season). That doesn't fit well with Divisional Round dogs seeking same-season revenge, currently standing at 16-7-1 ATS overall since 1996, including **9-1 ATS** when they own a. 625 or fewer win percentage. Word of caution: be sure to check the closing line on this game as NFL home favorites of fewer than six points ruled the roost this regular season, going 107-73-5 ATS.

## **BUFFALO** over Baltimore by 6

#### OPENING LINES: BILLS -1.5 / 51.5

t's MVP time in Buffalo where Josh Allen hosts Lamar Jackson in this must-watch Divisional showdown. The Ravens won the first meeting against Buffalo this season, 35-10, in Baltimore in Week Four, but the Bills won their last playoff meeting four years ago in the divisional round. As we called out in the Eagles write-up on these pages, we know that NFL favorites dominated this regular season, especially those favored by fewer than six points – yet they are 25-37-2 ATS in Divisional Round games, including 11-23-1 ATS when coming off a SUATS win. And for what it's worth, if you believe in karma, the Ravens have won the Super Bowl every 12 years this century (2001, 2013), and both titlewinning teams were led by 28-year-old QBs (Trent Dilfer, Joe Flacco). It's been 12 years since Baltimore hoisted the Lombardi Trophy... and Lamar Jackson is 28. There is no refuting the fact that the Ravens have devoured all eleven fellow playoff teams this season, going 8-3 SU and 11-0 ITS by an average of +121 net yards per game, whereas the Bills are only 3-3 SUATS and ITS by only +06 net yards per game. However, if you think that stat appears skewed, check out the Chiefs' NEGATIVE ATS and ITS stats on page 2. Note, though, that Buffalo made it twelve consecutive home wins while improving to **9-0 at home at Highmark Stadium this season** when they drilled Denver on Sunday, setting up this Divisional Round battle of streaking powerhouses. In addition, the Bills are 15-2 SU and 11-5-1 ATS at home in the playoffs when they sport the better record since 1989. Yes, the Black Birds enter on a 5-0 SUATS win streak – all by double-digits – since coming off their Bye week in mid-December. But you can't lay points in Buffalo. The Bills are simply too dangerous – and motivated.



## Ohio State over Notre Dame by 3

ow odd is it that Notre Dame QB Riley Leonard and Ohio State QB Will Howard were roommates at the Manning Passing Academy last summer? Or are Notre Dame and Ohio State listed side-by-side in the 2024 PLAYBOOK Football Preview Guide magazine? We're unsure if it mattered in their path to the first-ever 12-team College Football Playoff Championship Game. Nevertheless, they've both arrived. Notre Dame is riding a 13-game outright win streak, including an **11-0 ATS win skein**, on the heels of three straight wins over Top-10 ranked opponents. Despite suffering two tough losses earlier in the season to Oregon and Michigan, Ohio State has been nearly unstoppable since. Their performance in the CFP has been nothing short of dominant.

Ohio State claims the top spot for the best defensive leader in college football. The Buckeyes lead the nation in points allowed, with just 12.2 per game, and in yards allowed, with only 251.1 per game. Additionally, the team has recorded 51 total sacks, ranking third in the country.

Notre Dame is not far behind, boasting an impressive defense. The Fighting Irish rank No. 2 in points allowed with 14.3 points per game and No. 9 in yards allowed with 298.3 yards per game. While their 38 total sacks rank 17th nationally, their disciplined and aggressive play has made them a formidable opponent for opposing offenses.

How they got here: The eighth-seeded Buckeyes beat No. 9 Tennessee and No. 1 Oregon by a combined score of 83-38 before taking down No. 5 Texas, 28-14, in Friday's thrilling semifinal. The seventh-seeded Fighting Irish handled No. 10 Indiana and No. 2 Georgia before squeaking past No. 6 Penn State, 27-24. And neither of whom won a conference title this season. This is the ninth meeting between these two programs. Notre Dame won the first two games nearly a century ago (1935-36), but Ohio State has won all six since then (1995, 1996, 2006, 2016, 2022, 2023) to take a commanding lead in the all-time series. This will also be the first time since 2004-05 that no SEC teams will appear in backto-back FBS national championship games. From a here-and-now aspect, the favorites are 9-1 outright and 8-2 against the spread in this year's playoff. They'd be undefeated if it weren't for a surge of late money on Thursday that made Penn State a slight favorite over Notre Dame before kickoff.

On a sidebar note: Kevin R. from Hammond, IN, an astute Playbook client, informed us that there is a reason Notre Dame keeps winning games they are supposed to lose. It has to do with Irish QB Riley Leonard, who was quoted as saying, **"Those who** exalt themselves or praise themselves will be humbled, but those who humble themselves will be praised." Words to live by. FYI: Leonard wears this on his wrist every game. In closing, the Well-Oiled Machine notes that while underdogs are on a 5-0 ATS run in CFP title games, teams with a better win percentage are **3-0 ATS** all-time in CFP championship games if they scored more than 24 points in the semifinal round match.

In addition, Notre Dame head coach Marcus Freeman is 33-8 SU and 29-11 ATS in his career with the Irish, by an average margin of loss of 7 points per game ... with only three by double-digits. He is also **10-0 ATS** against foes coming off an ATS win of nine or more points and **31-1 outright** in games where the Irish have scored 24 or more points.

From a sheer excitement standpoint, it will be hard for this game to surpass the thrills we saw in Texas' win over Arizona State in the Fiesta Bowl quarterfinals. Cam Skattebo. Quinn Ewers. Two-point conversions. Missed field goals. Fourth-down conversions. Double overtime. That game, indeed, had it all. You can pay the toll and get in Ohio State backers' long, long public line. But you'll find us in the Nostradamus express lane, glued from start to finish in a game that figures closer than you think.
