Against the wind We were runnin' against the wind We were young and strong; we were runnin' Against the wind

verall, the song's meaning is about getting older. It's about pushing on in life and maturing through love, exploration, heartbreak, and betrayal. The title and the repeated phrase "against the wind," in particular, signal the passing of time. The catchphrase itself came from Bob Seger's days of running track and cross country in high school when he would literally "run against the wind."

The song of the same name was one of his most popular tunes, a No. 3 best-seller, for good reason too. It's an unoffensive, almost hypnotic mid-tempo ballad with lyricism that inspired the next generation of singer/songwriters. (Garth Brooks, Brooks & Dunn, and The Highwaymen all did their own covers of the song.) In fact, Eagles' singer/ songwriter Glenn Frey also provided backing vocals for the song. Seger and Frey met while working in the Detroit music scene, where they both grew up.

The title of the song is also a perfect metaphor for struggling NFL teams that have slogged their way through mediocrity. But being value seekers that we are, it also becomes a profit-making situation if we...

BET ON any NFL home dog from Game 14 onward with a .250 or fewer win percentage if they won four or fewer games last season.

And why not, as these face-in-thewind teams are 42-21 ATS in this role since 1988. Better yet, if their opponent scored fewer than 35 points in its last game. Dress them up as a home dog and they improve to 29-10 ATS.

Finally, pair them up against an opponent whose team net Yards Per Rush is not a positive (0 or less) they disappear like a felon in the Witness Protection program, going **16-1 ATS**.



PITTSBURGH over Kansas City by 3

Santa brought an early gift to both of these teams in this Christmas Day preview of what could be a playoff preview between two teams on a Wednesday, no less. That means the NFL has games scheduled every day this week except on Tuesday and Friday - the first such occurrence in league history. This is also known as a holiday gift as NFL teams that have clinched the No. 1 overall playoff seed in their previous game - read: Kansas City - have come flatter than an Aunt Jemima pancake. It's the opportunity to step back and catch their breath before the playoffs call. The Chiefs enter at 1-4 ATS in weekday games when coming off a win, while the Steelers have not only cashed in each of their last five games against AFC West foes, but they are also 18-5-5 ATS as home dogs under Mike Tomlin, including 11-1-2 ATS from Game Eight out. The Burghers also enter today's fray tied with Baltimore atop the AFC North. Still, they own the tiebreaker with the Ravens and are not anxious to give it up today, especially with the Black Birds set to kick off next against the Texans in the game following this. Political correctness aside, it's Pittsburgh's chance to say, "I'se in town, honey." And that is where the money should be in the holiday treat.

Baltimore over HOUSTON by 8

The Ravens clinched an AFC playoff berth after a convincing 34-17 win over the Steelers at M&T Bank Stadium on Saturday, but they want more. Despite the win, the Steelers still own the tie-brea¬ker advantage and will need a loss by Pittsburgh today or next week against the Bengals to take back the AFC North division lead. Conversely, the Texans captured their second consecutive AFC South title last week. They had better not uncork too much champagne, though, as the **MIDWEEK ALERT** notes, they are riding a 0-4 ITS (In The Stats) losing skein. In addition, the Ravens have dominated this series, going **4-0 SUATS** of late, and are **8-1 ATS** as road chalk of six or fewer points. With Huey riding a **0-4 ATS** losing streak in games after playing on Saturday, this looks like an opportune time for Lamar Jackson to further enhance his MVP chances today.

Thursday, December 26 3★ BEST BET Seattle over CHICAGO by 11

Talk about a dagger going through your heart; in the past two weeks, Seattle has fallen from the No. 3 seed in the NFC Playoff Picture to No. 9 this week. As a result, the Seahawks currently have an 11% chance of crashing the party. That improves to 30% with a pair of season-ending victories. All they can do at this point is to beat whoever they line up against, and it starts with the hibernating Bears today. In truth, it's more like comatose Chicago as they are immersed in a nine-game losing streak since their Bye week in late October, a result of having scored more than 20 points in only one contest since being hypnotized. On the other side of the field, Seattle checks in at **5-0 ATS** in the first of back-to-back road games. And as always, we save the best for last with **THE CLINCHER: NFL teams who faced the Detroit Lions in their previous game are 2-11-1 ATS this season, including 0-5-1 ATS at home.**

NEW ENGLAND over LA Chargers by 6

The late-season love for the Patriots is at work today and for all the right reasons. For openers, following a 16- SU and 1-5-1 ATS start to the season under new head coach Jerod Mayo, they've come together enough to go 5-3 ATS in games since, allowing more than 400 yards just once. Today marks their first game in Foxborough since Dec 1. They've gone **6-1 ATS** the last seven games in this series and are 6-2 ATS at home on Saturdays, which is a near mirror opposite of the Bolts' 2-8 ATS record in their last ten games on Saturdays. With the Chargers **0-5-1 ATS** after scoring 34-plus points in their previous contest, we turn it over to **THE CLINCHER: See Marc's 'Against The Wind' BETCHA DIDN'T KNOW column on Page 2 for a terrific 16-1 ATS winning angle that supports the Pats in this game.**

CINCINNATI over Denver by 13

A win here clinches a playoff berth for the Broncos. A loss today eliminates the Bengals from the postseason. What can we expect in this match-up today, you ask? It's a game with playoff intensity, for sure. Denver can clinch a playoff bid with a win today or next week. It currently holds the 7th and final playoff seed, while Cincinnati holds the No. 9 spot in the AFC playoff chain. Mathematically, Denver enters with a 76% chance of being playoff-bound, while Cincy clings to a scant 4% chance of earning a playoff berth. That improves to 14% with wins today and next week against the Steelers. Don't tell that to Joe Burrow, though. All he knows is his team is still breathing. We know that Burrow is 9-3-1 ATS in his NFL career against the ACW West, including 5-0 SUATS in the last five games as a host. In addition, the Striped Cats are 3-1-1 ATS on Saturdays, while the Broncos are 1-4 ATS on Saturdays. So, yes. Saturday is all right if you're a Bengal, and so is THE CLINCHER: The Bengals are 14-4 ATS against .600 or greater non-division opposition with Joe Burrow, including 9-3 SU and 10-2 ATS when Cincy enters off a SUATS win.

LA RAMS over Arizona by 12

Thwack! That was the sound of the rubber band we were forced to put away when pondering the thought of backing the southbound flying Cardinals against the ascending Rams. It snapped upon learning that Kyler Murray is just 13-29-1 SU and 17-23-1ATS from November out in his NFL career. Ouch. That hurt. Now on a 1-4 losing run since their Bye week before Thanksgiving, Zona knocked on the playoff door at 6-4 before they fattened up and began playing like turkeys thereafter. The onus now shifts to the Rams, who, thanks to an 8-2 effort since their Bye week, have cemented their seventh winning season in eight years under Sean McVay and can now clinch the NFC West with any of three possibilities, including two scenarios this week that include a win and a Seahawks loss or tie, or a tie and a Seattle loss. Hence, no rubber bands are allowed today. While we're not sure what McVay is serving his troops in team meals in post-Bye week games, they are 15-3 SU and 13-5 ATS the past two regular seasons after enjoying a respite. So, with the Redbirds 1-5 ATS in their last six division road games and the L.A. 8-1 ATS when seeking division revenge from a single loss, along with QB Matthew Stafford camped inside this week's INCREDIBLE STAT on this page, we're left with only one real option here today, and it's Ram Tough!

Sunday, December 29

Indianapolis over NY GIANTS by 3

Somehow, the inside-out Colts are back in the AFC Playoff Picture, holding down the No. 8 seed entering this week. They can thank the schedule maker for their success, as their last three wins have come at the expense of the Titans, the Patriots, and the Jets. Their reward today is taking on another sloth. It's so bad that they can't seem to get out of their own way. Following a promising 2-2 start to the

season, Big Blue went limp in a hurry as they ride a 10-game losing streak entering today's fray. With Indy **0-5 SUATS** in road finales, we can see the G-Men improving on their **5-0 ATS** ledger against the AFC South as the Colts throw another shoe today.

WASHINGTON over Atlanta by 7

The up-and-down Dirty Birds meet the resilient Commanders with much on the line for each team. Washington defeated Philadelphia last week despite turning the ball over five times to the Eagles. Meanwhile, the Falcons rode the young arm of first-round pick Michale Penix Jr. to the winner's circle in his first start in a convincing 27-point win over the Giants. However, what Jr. is about to learn today is a marked difference between the two NFC East rivals; one can play, and the other cannot. Atlanta currently resides in the No. 4 slot in the NFC Playoff Picture with only a 25% chance to make it to the postseason. A win today boosts that to 50%, and a pair of wins puts them in the playoffs, meaning they control their destiny as they would win the NFC South and clinch the No. 4 seed. On the other side of the coin, Washington is in if they win, either today or next week against the Cowboys. According to the '2-Minute Handicap' on page 3, the trends weigh heavily against the Falcons. With the Redskins, err, Commanders, 3-0 SUATS in this series, they gain the nod.

NEW ORLEANS over Las Vegas by 3

It's games like this that give the NFL a bad rap. Neither team can play. Neither one cares. Yet the game must continue because the league is heavily focused on marketing each team. It's too bad neither team can go on the IR. Nevertheless, the Saints return home red-faced following last week's pathetic performance on Monday Night Football when they lost 34-0 at Green Bay, marking the eighth time they've been whitewashed since at least 1980. It was also the 29th time a team was blanked under the Monday Night lights. These teams are just 6-10 ATS at home the following game and 2-7 ATS as home chalk. Coupled with the fact that the 'Aints are just **3-15 ATS** as AFC hosts, they appear like a team with leprosy. However, the Raiders bring little to the table in this battle of lepers, including a **0-6 ATS** mark against the NFC South. Warning: do not touch either team unless, of course, you're fond of patchy skin.

Tennessee over JACKSONVILLE by 3

Nothing is worse than backing a team in the season's final stages with a lame-duck coach. And that's the job description of both coaches in the contest – Doug Pederson of the Jaguars and Titans' interim head coach Mike McCoy. This means that neither team will likely be focused on this game. Instead, players and coaches from both teams are busy making tee times starting in January. We know that Jacksonville is 2-7 ATS of late as division home chalk, while Tennessee is 0-4 ATS in the second of consecutive road games. If that's of any help, you may require help if you're seriously contemplating playing this scrimmage.

BUFFALO over NY Jets by 8

If you do not believe in the meaning of 'letdown games,' look back to last week at Buffalo's effort against the pathetic Patriots. After flying higher than any team in the league in the previous ten games, the Bills came this close to laying an egg against the Pats last week. To their credit, they escaped and clinched the No. 2 seed in the AFC, but the door is still open to the possibility of catching top seed Kansas City if the Bills win their final two games and the Chiefs lose their last two contests. The Bills are certainly capable of holding up their end of the deal. The Chiefs will make things difficult, albeit Kansas City will be on the road for its final two games of the season. If you like the Jets, you can't enjoy their 0-3 SUATS record as dogs of 8 or more points. Nor the Bills' **6-1 ATS** mark in the second of consecutive home games. Fortunately, we don't like either.

TAMPA BAY over Carolina by 16

We love matchups of this sort at this stage of the season. Namely, a losing team coming off a win faces a winning team off a loss and is looking to secure a playoff berth. Both teams check each box. The Panthers cashed their sixth straight underdog ticket last week when they apple-carted Arizona while crushing their playoff hopes. Conversely, at the same time, the Buccaneers were tripped as a road favorite at Dallas and are now on the outside looking in at the NFC Playoff Picture. Right now, the Bucs hold a 57% chance of breaking through. That improves to 70% with a win here and 85% with a pair of season-ending victories. The good news is they have beat Carolina like a drum of late, winning eight of the last nine meetings while cashing eight of the previous eleven games as a division home favorite of five or more points. In addition, the Panthers are 0-5 SUATS in Game Sixteen of the season in the last five years. And then there is the Ugly Betty stat for QB Bryce Young, supplied this week by THE CLINCHER: Carolina is 0-9 SU and 2-6-1 ATS versus winning opponents behind QB Bryce Young, including 0-5 SUATS against opponents with an .800 or fewer win percentage.

Green Bay over Minnesota by 4

Packers have now made the playoffs in five of Matt LaFleur's six seasons with the team. An endorsement of his head coaching ability was the transformation of Jordan Love to starting quarterback after he took over for Aaron Rodgers. Many had insisted that Rodgers carried LaFleur, but it doesn't look that way today. Yes, the Packers scored 30-plus points in their last five games. What is not is that the Pack is hitting on all cylinders on defense, holding three of its previous five foes to season-low yardage. Yet they currently reside in 3rd place in the NFC North, yet they have clinched a playoff berth. And if Green Bay beats Minnesota by three or more points today and then Chicago next week, they will earn a higher seed than the Vikings - should Minny fall to Detroit on the season's final week. So yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus. The history book reminds us that the visiting team in this series is 3-0 ATS, and Green Bay is 6-1 ATS after hosting a Monday Night game, while Minnesota is 0-4 ATS as division home chalk of fewer than seven points. And then there is the round robin with the Packers **0-4 ATS** in Game Sixteen and the Vikes 0-4 ATS in Game Sixteen. If this were a tennis match, it would be game, set, match ... Green Bay.

It's lucky for the Eagles that **the host is 10-1 ATS** in this series. Otherwise, this treatise would be about the Cowboys' quest to avenge a season-worst 28-point home loss in early November. Cooper Rush's first start this season was filling in for an injured Dak Prescott, and Rush struggled mightily. He's since settled in, and as a result, the Boys are back in town, winning four of their last five games while enjoying playing spoiler. The Green Birds are still on hold with QB Jalen Hurts in concussion protocol. Until we know more about his condition, we'll keep our hands off our wallet. Dallas is **4-0 ATS** when seeking single revenge, while Philly is **0-9 ATS** as a favorite of eight or more points. Keep an eye on this line and, of course, Hurts' condition.

Miami over CLEVELAND by 8

The Dolphins had to be shivering in their skin when they found out they'd be traveling to Cleveland in December after visiting Buffalo in November last month. The good news for the Fish, though, is that temperatures are expected to be 50 degrees during this game on Sunday. But the truth is that when it's 50 degrees in Miami, it's considered friggin' cold to the natives. We know first-hand. The fact is the Dolphins are clinging to the slimmest of hope in making it to the postseason, currently the No. 9 seed in the AFC Playoff Picture with just a 2% chance. Wins here and next week against the Jets bump their chances up to ... 4%. Or, as Tony Soprano would say, "Fuggedaboutit!" However, as long as the door remains open, Miami will look to improve on its 4-0 ATS mark in the first of consecutive road games and also on its 13-3 ATS record against .400 or fewer foes. With the Browns going through the motions and just 1-6 ATS in their last seven games against the AFC East, there is only one way to look here. Chilled Dolphin, anyone?

SAN FRANCISCO over Detroit by 3

When was the last time the 49ers were a home dog, you ask? Try two years ago when they took one point against the Chiefs - and got shellacked. Kyle Shanahan is just 9-8 ATS when taking points, but as this week's TRIVIA TEASER on page 2 tells, he shines in this particular role today. The Niners are dead meat, eliminated from this year's playoffs. Then again, it's not headline news. In eight seasons with the 49ers, Shanahan has missed the playoffs four times. The 49ers' absence from the postseason will be the first time San Francisco will be on the outside looking in at the playoffs in three years. A 4-4 SUATS record at home this season didn't help. Nor did a multitude of injuries. The fact of the matter is that Frisco still owns the No. 2 overall ranked defense in the league. 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
