



A Weekly Insight Into The Art Of Sports Handicapping

hen the NFL asked Tom Petty to perform at halftime of the Super Bowl in 2008 he decided to do four full songs, rather than a medley of hits. In addition to "American Girl," "I Won't Back Down," and "Free Falling," Petty closed with "Running Down A Dream."

It was ironic given the fact that the undefeated New England Patriots, looking to run down a dream in their quest for perfection, suffered their only loss of the season to the New York Giants in a dramatic conclusion to the game. Thus, it became even more popular when ESPN played the song the next day during game highlights.

Hence, dreams of a memorable season can often go sideways at the worst of times. Just getting to the threshold of success requires greatness and a heavy helping hand from Dame Fortune herself. Without Lady Luck, there is a good chance a mediocre team will realize little reward.

In the NFL one thing is for certain: teams with porous rush defenses become money burners when cast into the role of a favorite. That's because if you can't stop the run, there will be little fun to be had. Taking it one step further, I strongly advise you to...

PLAY AGAINST any unrested NFL road pick or favorite from Game Nine out if they allow 4.6 or more yards per rush.

Teams in this role are just 65-107-7 ATS since 1988, including **34-64-1 ATS** if they scored 27 or more points in their last game. That would put **Buffalo and Cincinnati** in harm's way this Saturday.

Put them up against a non-division foe and they fall to 16-36-2 ATS, including **2-15-1 ATS** the last six seasons. The Bills just may be biting off more than they bargained for this Saturday. It will be all head coach Sean McDermott can do make sure his troops do not play down to the level of the lowly Chargers this Saturday, especially behind a super-soft rush defense. Good luck with that.

So if you're looking to run down a dreamy situation in the NFL

this year, follow the formula – and crank up the speakers while you're singing along with Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers.

"Yeah, runnin' down a dream
That never would
come to me
Workin' on a mystery.
Goin' wherever it leads
Runnin' down a dream."

3★ BEST BET

LA RAMS over New Orleans by 13

Seven games this week pairing .500 or greater teams, and this is one of them. For what it's worth, the league has witnessed 69 such matchups this season, with those teams coming off a win and taking points just 17-29-2 ATS as a dog. That would put New Orleans in a pickle this week. Meanwhile, this is a key battle for playoff positioning with the Rams currently holding down the No. 7 playoff seed, edging out the Saints as Los Angeles owns the better conference record, thus making this a playoff game in its own right. Our NFL Head Coaches' Database reminds us that Saints mentor Dennis Allen is 6-15 SU and 4-15-2 ATS in games when his team is coming off a win, including 1-7-1 ATS coming off a double-digit win. On the other side of the field, L.A.'s Sean McVay has taken care of business in games against NFC South foes, going 10-5 SU and 9-5-1 ATS. With the home team in this series, a stellar 8-0 SUATS, and Allen 0-4 SU and 0-3-1 ATS in his career in games when coming off consecutive ATS wins, you know what to do. Especially with added artillery coming from THE CLINCHER: The Well-Oiled Machine notes that NFL away teams from Game 15 out, coming off three consecutive home games - the last two outright wins - are 7-21 ATS, including 1-8 SUATS as a dog of 4-plus points.

Saturday, December 23

5★ BEST BET

PITTSBURGH over Cincinnati by 11

You know things are going bad in Pittsburgh for Mike Tomlin, with his 16-year career mark of never having suffered a losing season on the line, and he needs to resort to Mason Rudolph, who will be making his eleventh start as an NFL quarterback. However, he's gone 5-4-1 SU and 5-3-2 ATS, including a 2-0 SU and 1-0-1 ATS slate against the Bengals. It's Tomlin's 22-9 SU and 17-12-1 ATS ledger in games when the Steelers enter dead-level .500 that serves as the starting point today, though. We realize the Steelers' OL has been offensive this season and is a large contributing reason that starting QB Kenny Pickett resides on the IR. We're also aware of the fact that the Black and Gold are averaging 13 points over their last five games as they enter today's game with less than a 5% chance of making this year's playoffs, per CBS Sports. Fortunately for Pittsburgh, the Colts and Texans play each other in Week 18, so one of those teams will suffer a seventh loss. Both the Texans and Colts have tiebreakers over Pittsburgh. though, after beating the Steelers earlier this season. This means that the Steelers will have to finish with a better record than both squads - which means winning out is mandatory for Tomlin's troops. Tomlin can also lean on his 11-7 SU mark in games against .550 or greater foes in which Pittsburgh is riding a 3-game losing streak, including 5-0 SUATS the last five games in the Steel City. Meanwhile, the Bengals lug a 2-6 SU and 3-5 ATS mark in Saturday road games into the fray, including 0-5 SUATS against foes coming off back-to-back losses - which ties nicely into the Steelers' 4-0 SUATS ledger as a host on regular season Saturdays. And finally, if Marc's **AWESOME ANGLE** on page 2 isn't enough, we can always lean on THE CLINCHER: Pittsburgh head coach Tomlin is 11-4 SU and 9-5-1 ATS at home in games when the Steelers sport a .500 exact win percentage, including 4-0 SUATS as a dog.

Buffalo over LA CHARGERS by 6

Whoa, Nellie. A lot has happened surrounding this game since the Westgate SuperBook installed Buffalo as a 1-point favorite prior to the start of the season, the most obvious of which would be the loss of Chargers' star QB Justin Herbert. But there's more ... lots more ... including the recent firing of Bolts' head coach Brandon Staley, not to mention the recent reawakening of the suddenly relevant Bills. The



hand we're now forced to play is either an L.A. squad that has been a double-digit home dog only one time since at least 1980 but is 5-0 ATS in its last five games in a double-digit underdog role - or a runaway train herd of Bills that has won each of their last six games on Saturdays by an average win margin of 17 points per game, but is only **0-6 ATS** in its last six games as a double-digit favorite? We do know the Bills lose the conference tiebreakers with Cincinnati as well as the Colts and the Texans, and we're sure head coach Sean McDermott does too. The Chargers' head coach Brandon Staley became the second Bolts' head coach to be fired midseason since 1970, joining Kevin Gilbride, who was fired in 1998 and replaced by June Jones. So, while Los Angeles looks to be little more than roadkill at this stage of the season, we would advise you not to feast on the carcass. For openers, the Bills are 1-7 ATS against foes coming off a loss of 21-plus points, as well as 7-11 ATS as road chalk of eight or more points. In addition, Buffalo has struggled in this series, going 1-4 SUATS in the last five meetings. And the MIDWEEK ALERT jumps in noting that Buffie allows 4.6 yards per rush on defense. For what it's worth, NFL road favorites who surrender 4.6 or more yards per rush are just 5-13-1 ATS this century. With the Bills eyeing up a pair of season-ending division duke outs, we make this our 'caveat emptor' call of the week - buyer beware.

Sunday, December 24

Indianapolis over ATLANTA by 6

The Colts are kicking up a storm this season under freshman head coach Shane Steichen while clinging to the No. 7 and final seed in the AFC Playoff Picture, holding tiebreakers over both Houston and Buffalo. It means every game is important moving forward, namely winning the ones they are expected to win (read: favored). The good news is they will close out the season at home the final two weeks against the Raiders and Texans. The only thing promising for the Falcons, should they need it, is they own the head-to-head tiebreaker over Green Bay, at the moment a game out of the NFC Wild Card spot after last week's gut-wrenching loss at Carolina. They'll turn to the H-bomb today with rag-rag QB Taylor Heinicke back behind center where he enters 12-15-1 SU and 13-14-1 ATS as a starter in his NFL career. The problem is the Dirty Birds are 7-16 ATS at home under head coach Arthur Smith, as well as 13-18 SU and 10-20-1 ATS overall in non-division games including 1-12 ATS in their last thirteen non-division games. With the Horseshoes **6-1 ATS** the last seven games in this series, we'll ride the hotter hand with the Colts.

Green Bay over CAROLINA by 8

The Packers took a big tumble in the NFC Playoff Picture with last week's home loss to the Buccaneers, dropping to No. 11 while losing the head-to-head tiebreaker to the Falcons. Meanwhile, despite last week's win over Atlanta, the Panthers are one of six teams that have

officially been eliminated from the playoffs. To no one's surprise, Carolina is 1-9 SU and 3-7 ATS lately when coming off a win. They are also 1-4 ATS against the NFC North. The Packers enter this fray as the No. 11 overall seed in the current NFC Playoff Picture and should be fully focused here. With head coach Matt LaFleur 16-9 ATS in his career when coming off a loss, including 10-5 SU and 11-4 ATS from game Eight out, you know exactly what to do.

HOUSTON over Cleveland by 3

When it comes to NFL Coach of the Year, Cleveland's Kevin Stefanski has to be in the mix. He became the first Browns' head coach since Marty Schottenheimer in 1988 to have two winning seasons in his tenure, and he's done it despite having 26% of the team's salary cap on the IR most of the season. Cleveland avoided a Hail Mary disaster on the final play of the game last week when a Bears' receiver failed to hold on to a ball that landed in his lap in the end zone. It upped the Browns' record this season to five wins when trailing with less than 2:00 remaining in the 4Q. If nothing else, it speaks to the importance of what owning the league's top-ranked defense does for you - it helps keep you alive deep into the game. Needless to say, this is a huge game for the Texans, who, with a win today, would move into a tie with Cleveland - but Houston would then hold the tiebreaker. At press time it appeared more likely than not that star rookie phenom QB C.J. Stroud was not going to move off the concussion protocol. As a result, for the second straight week a 5-point line swing has swung the Browns to the favorite at press time. If Stroud is sidelined, it means Case Keenum would be going up against his former teammates. He'll bring a 19-12-2 ATS career dog log into this fray, including 10-1-1 ATS against foes coming off consecutive wins. With the Texans 6-1 ATS in their last seven games against winning foes, and the Brownies 1-7 ATS the last eight games in this series, we can only look one way here today with the Texans' back up against the playoff wall.

UPSET GAME OF THE WEEK UPSET

TENNESSEE over Seattle by 3

Each team enters today's contest with disparate results – at least from a mental aspect. The Titans blew a late lead and lost at home in overtime to Houston, while the Seahawks rallied from the clouds to pull out a last-second shocker over the Eagles on Monday night. As such, Seattle takes the field as the No. 8 seed in the current NFC Playoff Picture, while the Titans are looking forward to the 2024 campaign. With it, however, the pressure mounts on a Seahawks' squad that has now been outgained in each of their last four games as they bring along a phony sense of accomplishment. Given Seattle's 0-5 outright record in road games this season since its Bye Week, and Tennessee's 6-1 ATS mark in this series, look for the Titans to improve on its 13-5 SU and 11-6-1 ATS at home off a loss under Mike Vrabel, including 4-0 SUATS this season. And look for the Seabags to a taste of touch of reality today, especially with Ryan Tannehill rumored to be behind center for the Titans today.

Washington over NY JETS by 3

What a difference a week makes in the lives of New York football faithful. The Giants were riding high on a 'where-did-that-comefrom' three game win streak, while the Jets laid a 24-point loss on C.J. Stroud and the Texans. However, it didn't take long for reality to settle in when, one week later they combined to score a total of just 6 points in a pair of wipeout losses last Sunday. The Jets had 4 vards of offense in the first half of last week's 30-0 whitewash loss to their division rival and will now have missed the NFL playoffs for 13 seasons in a row while going 19 games without a touchdown of the past seven seasons. Like the Jets, the Commanders have their gold bags packed too. Washington, though, is 5-0 ATS in its last five nonconference road games as well as 8-1-1 ATS as a non-division dog of 4 or fewer points. Marc's Well-Oiled Machine seals the deal, though, as it notes that Game Fifteen non-division teams coming off five losses exactly are 15-3 ATS when coming off a pair of ATS losses. That's all we needed to hear.

MINNESOTA over Detroit by 4

The Lions are up three games over the Vikings in the NFC North and are currently the No. 3 seed in the conference. They trail the 49ers by one game for the top record in the conference. On the other side of





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the field, Minnesota enters as the No.6 seed in the NFC Playoff Picture, thus assuring this contest will likely be in a playoff atmosphere. However, the team that can least likely afford a loss is the 7-7 Vikings, as no less than four other seven-win teams are in pursuit. Much like the Cleveland Browns, Team Thor is operating on their fourth starting quarterback this season – yet they still remain in playoff contention. A tip of the hat to head coach Kevin O'Connell as it's been a nice year for the coaching Kevin's this campaign. With Minnesota sporting a 6-0 ATS log as division home dogs, as well as 13-2 ATS as a dog off a loss when facing a foe coming off a win as a favorite, the points become the play in this division fray today.

Jacksonville over TAMPA BAY by 4

Three up and three down. It's an MLB term, but it applies here with the Bucs riding a three-game win streak - and with it, they sit atop the NFC South with the No. 4 seed in the NFC Playoff Picture. Meanwhile, despite a recent 0-3 SUATS losing slide, the Jaguars still sit atop the AFC South with tiebreakers over the Texans and Colts. Tampa Bay was already facing a banged-up Jacksonville Jaguars team this week and now, it might get worse when Sunday comes around as Jacksonville announced on Monday that quarterback Trevor Lawrence has entered concussion protocol after his game against the Baltimore Ravens on Sunday night. Lawrence did not leave the game for a concussion but was evaluated and then placed in protocol afterward. Lawrence has never missed a start due to injury, so this would be his first time should he not play against the Bucs. However, only one quarterback so far this season has made it out of concussion protocol the same week he entered it, as San Francisco 49ers QB Brock Purdy did so after playing the Minnesota Vikings earlier in the year. The NFL protocol process involves passing through five steps. Things move sequentially, starting with gentle activity like stretching and progressing through more and more intense work. If the player doesn't have "an increase or aggravation of signs or symptoms" after the prescribed activities, he can advance to the next level. Also, an independent neurological consultant has to clear the player to officially return to the lineup. Warming up in the bullpen will be Jags' QB C. J. Beathard, who played in relief of Lawrence when he suffered an ankle sprain against the Cincinnati Bengals and completed 12 of his 14 passing attempts for 77 yards. Beathard is 2-10 SU and 5-7 ATS overall in his NFL career starts. On the other side of the field, Tampa QB Baker Mayfield had a record-setting perfect game last week on the road against the Packers. Mayfield became the third quarterback in NFL history to record over 375 passing yards, four touchdown passes, and a 158.3 passer rating in a road game, including the first ever at Lambeau Field. Sunday's game also marked the first time he's thrown for a perfect passer rating. You know of our desire to fade teams and quarterbacks after record-breaking performances. While Jacksonville is just 2-10 SUATS in its last twelve games against the NFC South, they are 6-1 ATS away this season, while Tampa Bay enters just 1-6 ATS hosting .600 or greater opponents. Should Lawrence be watching the game from the sidelines, look for a "rally around the backup" effort from the Jags in support of its missing leader. Should he start, we'll be ready to snap the rubber band.

MIAMI over Dallas by 13

We're going to learn a lot about each of these teams this week. Despite the fact that each is currently ranked No. 2 in their respective conferences in the current NFL Playoff Picture, both come with warts. The white elephant in the room wonders whether the Cowboys can win road games and if the Dolphins can't beat a winning team. So, what gives here, with Dallas just 6-15 SUATS away in its last twenty-one games against winning foes - including 0-3 SUATS this year by an average loss margin of 23 PPG – and Miami is 6-14 outright versus teams with a winning record, including 0-3 SUATS this season. One would think this to be a battle for the cellar rather than for the top seeds. Tua completed 21 of 24 passes in last week's 30-0 dismantling of the Jets, as they have scored 30-plus points eight times this season. Our biggest concern today, though, is they mustered only 290 yards of offense, meaning the cuffs and the collars don't match. While they are currently the No. 2 seed in the AFC Playoff Picture, Miami can claim the top-seed should it win out - and it would certainly deserve so, having to go up against the likes of the Cowboys here, and the Ravens and Bills to conclude the campaign. Fortunately, they are 9-2 SUATS at home coming off a home game as a favorite after dressing up as a favorite the previous game, including 6-0 ATS when not favored by seven or more points. Meanwhile, Dallas has a -4 point differential on the road in 2023 (14th in the NFL) while leading the league with a +171 point differential at home in 2023 - and that's with a 40-point road win in its season opener at the Giants. We button this up with THE CLINCHER: NFL home favorites coming off a home shutout win are 10-2 SU and 9-3 ATS since 2000 against an opponent coming off an away game, including 7-0 SUATS if they sport a sub .750 win percentage.

CHICAGO over Arizona by 1

Odds are there will not be many eyeballs tuned into the game as these two losers bring a combined total of eight victories this season into this contest. It's been the Cardinals that have captured the cash in the series, going 5-1 ATS. They are also 7-3 ATS in the first of back-to-back road games and 9-2 ATS in their last eleven non-division games. Traveling down the Bear path, we find Chicago just 1-5 ATS as short non-division home chalk of 6 or fewer points, as well as 2-5 SUATS in its last seven games against the NFC West. Connect the dots.

DENVER over New England by 10

The Broncos fell all the way to the No. 11 seed in the AFC Playoff Picture with last week's loss to the Lions. They are now one game out of the final playoff spot and drop the conference record tiebreaker to the Steelers. But with a quick glance at the schedule, we note the Wild Horses have a very manageable itinerary with the Chargers and the Raiders up next to close out the campaign. A 10-1 SU and 10-0-1 ATS dog log in games when both teams are coming off underdog losses in their previous game, sets the table. The Pats' piss-poor 1-11 SUATS mark in their last dozen non-division tilts seals the deal.

Monday, December 25

KANSAS CITY over Las Vegas by 14

A game that had all the promise at the beginning of the season is simply another circus act in Vegas. Surprisingly, the line set in this game at the Westgate SuperBook in Las Vegas before the season started was the Chiefs -9.5, which is where it sits today. This means, more than anything else, Kansas City has underperformed this season. That is until you review their body of work in the **MIDWEEK ALERT** this week, where the Chiefs are one of only five teams in the league that sport both a Top 10 offense and a Top 10 defense, which should not have a problem against Las Vegas' 28th-ranked offense. We realize they are only 0-3 ATS coming off their previous three wins this season,

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and the Raiders are the second foe in a row that will take on the Chiefs with a rest advantage, but when coming off a win of late Andy Reid is 15-1 SU in his last sixteen division games when coming off one win exactly, and 71-28 ATS in games he wins outright as a favorite against foes arriving off a win. With NFL teams **1-5 SU and 0-6 ATS** since 1989 in games after scoring 60-plus points in their last games, we're randy for Andy this week.

PHILADELPHIA over NY Giants by 16

Oh my. The chant Fly Eagles Fly has turned to Cry Eagles Cry lately. Riding a three-game losing skid for the first time since closing out the 2020 season, Philadelphia was 24-4 in the previous 28 regular season games prior to their three-game losing streak, and despite the sky falling they can still win the NFC East by winning out. This looks to be the first major step in that direction as they've beaten Big Blue like a red-headed stepchild of late, going 25-6 SU and 18-12-1 ATS since 2008. In addition, previous year Super Bowl losing teams are on a 9-1 SU and 7-3 ATS run when playing off three successive losses, including **3-0 SUATS** at home by an average win margin of 14 points per game. With the Giants returning to earth after a rare three-game win streak despite being outgained in each of their last seven games and just 0-3 ATS against .666 or greater foes this year, we look for the birds to fly high tonight.

SAN FRANCISCO over Baltimore by 3

You can rest assured that if this game was not being played on Christmas Day, it would have been the highest-rated Monday Night game in NFL history. It is already a possible Super Bowl preview between the two No. 1 seeds. Yes, this is a must-see, prime-time television. And, as you might expect, each team brings an arsenal of good numbers into the game. Baltimore is 6-3 SU and **7-1-1 ATS** away on Mondays, including 4-0-1 ATS as a dog. Better yet, star QB Lamar Jackson is 18-1 SU in his career against NFC opposition. The Black Birds are also 11-2 ATS against .700 or great foes. And speaking of superstars, for the 37th time in his NFL career, Jackson led his team in both rushing and passing yards in the same game in last week's 23-7 win versus Jacksonville. On the other side of the coin, Niners' RB Christian McCaffrey is the only NFL player all-time with 1,000 rushing and receiving yards in the same season - and he still has three games to go. Like Baltimore, San Francisco is 7-1 ATS against .700 or better opponents. Ravens' head coach John Harbaugh brings an exceptional 80-53-9 ATS career mark as a visitor, while 49ers head coach Kyle Shanahan is 15-3 SU and 11-6-1 ATS at home in his career when the Niners sport a .750 or greater win percentage. In a battle of the league's best, we'll grab the points.




